The social worker undertakes a liaison role, maintaining regular contact with the Hub carer, providing support, guidance and supervision for the constellation carers.</p> <p>The role will require the post holder to be innovative, creative, supportive, group work orientated and aware of contemporary care demands and ensuring the Mockingbird model becomes embedded within the wider Flintshire Foster care community.</p> <p>Working with a wide variety of agencies and professionals the role requires commitment, flexibility and a thorough understanding of all relevant Fostering standards and the Social Services and Well Being Act (2014) Wales. The role demands the ability to build effective relationships with social services teams and forge strong collaborative partnerships with other agencies.
