An exciting opportunity has arisen for a Senior Practitioner Occupational Therapist to join our service working to support adults of all ages in their own homes across Flintshire.

The post holder will be required to use a strengths focused approach to carry out collaborative assessments with people to determine their outcomes, analysing their functional abilities, their environments and significant occupations prior to making recommendations and carrying out interventions.

A good working knowledge of equipment and both minor and major adaptations alongside knowledge of techniques and condition management will help the applicant increase the independence and wellbeing of those with complex physical conditions and other associated conditions. A good understanding and experience of manual handling and supporting legislation would be invaluable in this post. Excellent communication skills are required to work with multi-disciplinary team members, citizens and their families as well as other agencies that support our practice. Excellent recording and computer skills are also required. In addition, as a senior practitioner, you would be involved in the clinical supervision of Occupational Therapists within the team, both individually and in a group as required, as well as supporting the development of the Occupational Therapy service, providing advice to Team Managers and colleagues across the service and working closely with the North West Locality Team Manager and Senior Prac. Social Worker to triage and allocate cases.

A good structure of supervision and support is available for the successful applicant, in line with the Royal College of Occupational Therapists Career Framework guidance.

The ability to speak Welsh is Desirable
