

An exciting job opportunity has arisen within our Paediatric OT service. The job involves specialist assessment of children, young adults and families to identify their occupational needs. We focus on a child's strengths and abilities to overcome occupational barriers within the context of their home environment/placement. We believe in active listening to ensure our focus remains on the child's/families and caregivers' personal outcomes. We take a positive approach to risk and underpin our decisions by working closely with the child, young person, family alongside our colleagues in Social Work and health. We encourage and value diversity within practice and are always supportive of the alternative model or approach to reach personalised planning and interventions. The successful candidate can expect; clinical supervision every 6 weeks with a senior Occupational Therapist, peer group every 4 weeks, access to in house training and specialist training. We also have access to our training room to practice with manual handling equipment, often with other Occupational Therapists. We have annual appraisals which focus on the 4 pillars of practice and encourage reflection and CPD. We have a welcoming team where practitioners are encouraged to develop their clinical skills within a supportive team environment.
