Our Area Supervisors are employed to manage and motivate teams of Community Play Team Members to provide informal play sessions at towns and villages across Flintshire to deliver the county summer playscheme programme for all children aged between 5 and 12 years. The Area Supervisor position is vital to the successful delivery of the playscheme programme. Area Supervisors are responsible for communication between children, parents, the Play Development team and partner organisations, thus ensuring the smooth running of the scheme. This challenging position requires enthusiasm and endless amounts of energy. An ability to use your own initiative, to think on your feet and problem solve spontaneously is essential.

Area Supervisors will be responsible for delivering part of the training package for Community Play Team Members and volunteers and will be expected to speak in public to large numbers of team members.
